Foreign Language Requirement:

Students who have not taken two years of the same foreign language in high school must complete two semester or 8 credit hours of the same foreign language at the college level to meet the foreign language requirement.

Capstone Guidance:

- Students must have completed the foreign language requirement, all General Education courses, all Technical Core courses and all
 Organizational Management core courses and must meet with an advisor in order to register for the Capstone course. The only
 courses permitted to be taken with the Capstone course are GEB4891 and one of the three elective courses.
- GEB4970 is recommended for online students and students who plan to attend graduate school. For students taking GEB4970,
 6 credits of electives are required. For students taking MAN4900, 3 credits of electives are required.



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
