Completion Rate

The Expected Level of Achievement: 70% of the students will complete the RN-BSN Nursing Program within 150% of the program length, beginning with enrollment in their first nursing course. Starting in 2022, the program length was modified to 100%, and the Expected Level of Achievement was modified to 30% beginning with the enrollment in students' first nursing course.
