



Welding Selective- Admission Steps

Interested in Joining Indian River's Welding Program? Below are the Selective Admission Steps:

1. Must Register and Attend One Welding Information Session, within 3 months of application. Events will be held at the Eastman Workforce Complex on the Ft. Pierce Campus. Students will meet with instructors and receive program information and expectations.
2. Submit Your College Application for the upcoming term--Spring or Fall (Traditional or Dual Enrollment). To begin, select "Apply" on the home page, www.irsc.edu

Submit a New Application (you will log in or create a new account). Please mark the following in your Academic Program of Interest:

Application Term – Fall or Spring with Year; Application Student type: College Freshman; Area of Study – Industry, Manufacturing, and Construction; Degree – Vocational Certificate; Application Major- V.C.-Welding Technology*.

3. Schedule an Interview. Applicants will participate in a group interview followed by the needed entry Math & Measuring test. A letter inviting you to schedule your interview and math test will be emailed to the email address you listed during your check-in at the information session.
4. The Program Acceptance Decision will be made 7-10 days after the last interview day. A letter will be sent to your email. If an applicant is not chosen, they are encouraged to reapply for the next Session.
