



Welding Selective Admission Steps

1. Attend a Welding Information Session

Register for and attend **one Welding Information Session** within three months of submitting your **application**. Sessions are held at the **Eastman Workforce Complex Maker Space on the Fort Pierce Campus** and include:

- Program information and expectations
- Meeting with welding instructors
- A tour of the welding facility

2. Submit Your College Application

Apply for the upcoming **Spring or Fall term** (Traditional or Dual Enrollment) during the designated **Application Window**.

Important: Welding Technology will only appear as an available major during the application window.

Apply at www.irsc.edu/admissions/apply/ and select **"Apply Now."** You will need to log in or create an account. Be sure you select:

- **Application Term:** Fall or Spring + Year
- **Student Type:** College Freshman
- **Area of Study:** Industry, Manufacturing, and Construction
- **Degree:** Vocational Certificate
- **Major:** V.C. – Welding Technology*

3. Complete the Interview & Math Test

After your Information Session attendance and application are verified, you will receive an email inviting you to schedule your **Group Interview and Math & Measuring Test**.

The invitation will be sent to the email address provided at the Information Session. **Please monitor your email regularly.**

4. Receive Your Admission Decision

Admission decisions will be emailed **7–10 days after the final interview day**.

Students who are not selected are encouraged to **reapply during the next application cycle**.
