



WILL MY DEGREE/CERTIFICATE PROGRAM QUALIFY ME TO WORK IN MY STATE OF RESIDENCE?

Indian River State College (IRSC) offers a number of degree and certificate programs that prepare students for professional licensure or certification that qualify them for their chosen career. If your plans include achieving licensure or certification, you should know the requirements for professional employment vary by state.

The attached chart provides information about the degree/certificate programs offered at Indian River State College that meet state/territory requirements across the nation. Even when graduates are eligible for a national certification exam, there are instances when individual states have requirements beyond those that Florida has mandated. Please review the table below for your program of study and possible work eligibility in your state. Also consider contacting the professional regulatory agency in the state you reside to learn about their credentialing requirements.

Key:

- **“Yes”** Indian River State College has determined that the program’s curriculum meets educational requirements for professional licensure certification for these states/US territories.
